
How to read the IDS Project's Transaction Performance Analysis Module (TPAM)

What is the TPAM?


The IDS TPAM is a collection of four applications which provide different views of the ILLiad transaction data of each of the IDS Libraries.



The web interface to the **TPAM** lays out two separate analysis pathways to select from. The first uses just the top parameters to generate the **Project Overview Chart** (shown below) which illustrates the average transaction times of all of the IDS Libraries. Cells colored green mean the turnaround time meets the shared benchmark (Articles 48 hrs., Loans 72 hrs.) and red indicates exceeding the benchmark. White cells indicate no transaction filled for the set parameters. Each cell has a mouse-over that describes total transactions between borrowing and lending.



The second analysis uses both the top parameters, and the bottom menus to select the borrowing and lending libraries, and the type of report you would like to generate. (You can also generate this chart by clicking on the cell in the Project Overview Chart). The first report is the **Transaction Analysis** which analyzes the IDS requests between a borrowing and a lending library and breaks them into specific points in time. For example, the amount of time on **average** it takes from when a patron requests an article to the time at which the borrowing library uploads this information to OCLC is represented by one of the colored columns on the graph. This chart analyzes six processes times, and provides a total average between any two libraries (borrower and lender), for either articles or loans.



The **Transaction Report** breaks down the time of each individual ILL transaction processed on the previous chart. It includes transaction and OCLC number, time request was received by borrower, sent to OCLC, imported by lender, search & retrieval, item sent, request received by borrower, and patron notified. It also includes the total transaction time for each request processed between two libraries.



To access the individual ILL Tracking History, click on the ILL# from the Transaction Report.

The **Tracking History** analyzes the entire history of individual IDS request transaction, from the moment it is received by the borrower to the time the patron is notified of its arrival at the borrowing institution



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
