Approximately 200 participants, including Library Directors, Information Technology Librarians, and staff involved with Resource Sharing workflows, are expected to attend. The IDS Project is growing and as of April, 2017, eighty-three member libraries from New York State are part of the cooperative. The Project has also expanded outside of New York with twenty-one libraries in Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, District of Columbia, Hawaii, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Mexico, Texas, Vermont, and Virginia. An additional twenty-one libraries, including Yale, Northwestern, and Cornell, are part of the IDS Logic subscription service for interlibrary loan automation.

Each 25 minute conference session requires a \$1,000 sponsorship contribution, for a maximum of two sessions.
